

A class of non-globally solvable vector fields on surfaces

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Abstract

We consider a smooth and non-vanishing complex vector field $L = X + iY$ satisfying condition (\mathcal{P}) , and we show that if L has a closed one-dimensional orbit on which $X \wedge Y$ vanishes of order 1, then L is not globally solvable.
